You can help in one of two ways:

2. Revise an online course, lesson or unit, that you have been using to align to the Michigan Learns Online Portal rubrics and provide supportive material. Approved work will be compensated; \$175 for an online learning lesson, \$250 for a multi-week unit, and \$325 for a trimester or longer online course.

Material submitted to the Michigan Learns Online Portal requires signed permission from your building principal. A Creative Commons license allowing others to use this content and adapt it for different classrooms is also required.
